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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ARIZONA COUNCIL OF CHAPTERS (TROA), INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Arizona, and the internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, and do hereby adopt these Articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I

NAME: The name of the corporation shall be: ARIZONA COUNCIL OF CHAPTERS (TROA), INC. 64分

ARTICLE II

INCORPORATORS: The names and addresses of the incorporators are: Donald F. Costello, 2619 W. Isabella, Mesa, Arizona 85202; Beverly J. Dunlap, 336 S. 74th Place, Mesa, Arizona 85208; and Raymond C. Hitzel, 7025 N. 47th Street, Scottsdale, Arizona 85253.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE: The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which nonprofit corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Arizona, as they may be amended from time to time.

ARTICLE IV

INITIAL BUSINESS: The corporation is organized and operated exclusively to establish a nonprofit veterans organization within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (19) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, including for such purpose the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c) (19) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws).

ARTICLE V

No part of the net earning of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV. No

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substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (19) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws).

ARTICLE VI

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the board of directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of its assets exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws) as the board of directors shall determine. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, as provided by applicable provisions of the Internal Revenue Service Code and the Arizona Revised Statutes.

ARTICLE VII

INDEMNIFICATION: The power of indemnification under the Arizona Revised Statutes shall not be denied or limited by the bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII

ANNUAL MEETING: The annual meeting is to be held at a place within or without the state as fixed by the bylaws.

ARTICLE IX

STATUTORY AGENT: The name and address of the initial statutory agent of the corporation is: Donald F. Costello, 2619 W. Isabella, Mesa, Arizona 85202.

ARTICLE X

BYLAWS: The power to adopt bylaws and to alter, amend or repeal the bylaws, subject to repeal or change by the action of the members to change the Articles of Incorporation, shall be vested and reserved to the members.

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ARTICLE XI

EXEMPTION: The private property of the directors and members of this corporation shall forever be exempt from all corporate debts and liabilities.

ARTICLE XII

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: There shall be no less than three directors.
